First, well Basically the first thing to do is, you invite your friend to come with you so you're not alone, you know!

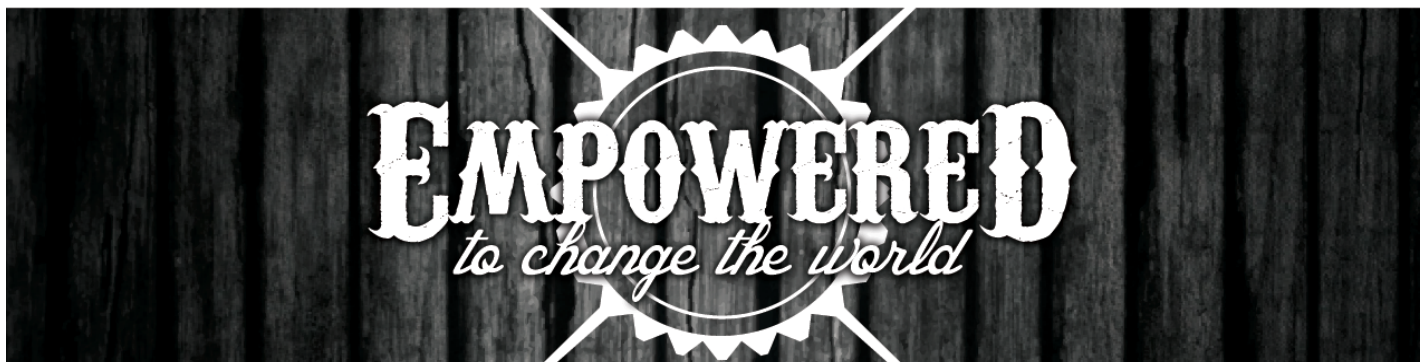
Second, read the rest of these forms. You and Your Parent need to sign what needs to be signed and then turn them in.

Student Behavior Contract
